## WHAT IS IT & WHY SHOULD I DO IT?

The DofE is a programme of activities set up by The Duke of Edinburgh over 50 years ago to give young people the chance to discover new ideas and challenges.

It's a flexible programme, where you can decide what activities you do.

Taking part in The Duke of Edinburgh's Award can give you new experiences, independence, a sense of achievement, self-confidence, leadership & teamwork skills and the chance to make new friends.

The DofE is very highly regarded by universities and employers, and is often the first thing they will look for on your UCAS form or CV.

## WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

To achieve your award, you will need to complete four different sections:

### VOLUNTEERING

Make a real difference in your community (e.g. helping at a youth club, supporting the elderly or running a fundraising or social action project).

### PHYSICAL

Anything that gets you moving... from archery to zumba, football to salsa dancing.

### SKILLS

Discover a new skill or develop an existing talent (e.g. learning to play a musical instrument, film making or public speaking and debating).

### EXPEDITION

An overnight expedition planned by you, during which you will be totally self-sufficient (Bronze – 2 days, Silver – 3 days, Gold – 4 days).

### RESIDENTIAL (Gold only)

Undertake a shared activity in a residential setting away from home for 5 days and 4 nights.



Did you know that if you are involved in JLGB's weekly activities you can now count your Enterprise Award credits towards your different DofE sections.

There are three levels – **Bronze**, **Silver** and **Gold**.

**You can start at Bronze in year 9, Silver in year 10 or Gold from age 16.**

Minimum participation: **Bronze – 6 months**,  
**Silver – 6 to 12 months** and **Gold – 12 to 18 months.**



## HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

We are proud that JLGB's kosher DofE provision for the Jewish Community is supported by the Pears Foundation. This enables us to provide training and expeditions at highly subsidised prices.

The cost includes: enrolment to The Duke of Edinburgh's Award; training sessions; support materials and the use of JLGB's expedition equipment: tents, sleeping mats, rucksacks, maps, compasses, stoves and pans.

The only additional costs for the Expedition Section will be for personal equipment: a suitable pair of walking boots, walking socks, sleeping bag, waterproof jacket and food for your expedition. During your training, advice will be given on what personal equipment is most suitable.

- Silver: Volunteering, plus Skills or Physical for 6 months & the other for 3 months
- Gold: Volunteering, plus Skills or Physical for 12 months, the other for 6 months & a 5 day Residential

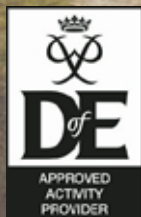
